**It's time to renew your license!
Your current license expires *July 31, 2010.***

RENEW ON-LINE

On line renewals are processed within 5 working days or less!

1. Enter the *Online License Renewal System* from our website at www.LSBEP.org. From the home page click on "Licensees Only". Then choose "Renew Your License Online".
2. To log in, enter your "User Name". This is your first name followed by a period followed by your last name: **Example: mickey.mouse**. If this is the first time you've used this system, your "Password" will be your social security number, no dashes: **Example: 123456789**.
3. Go to "License Renewal", read and check the attestations, and proceed with your payment. Only visa or master card are accepted.

PAPER RENEWAL

Allow 2-3 weeks for processing paper renewals.

1. Review and complete Sections I, II and III on the back of this form. Please update any address or phone information on this form. **Renewal Application is not valid unless the attestations are completed and initialed by the psychologist.**
