Your current license expires *July 31, 2011.***

RENEW ONLINE

Online renewals are processed immediately!

1. Enter the *Online License Renewal System* from our website at www.LSBEP.org. From the home page click on "*Licensees Only*". Then choose "*Renew Your License Online*".
2. To log in, enter your "**User Name**". This is your first name followed by a period followed by your last name: **Example: mickey.mouse**. If this is the first time you've used this system, your "**Password**" will be your social security number, no dashes: **Example: 123456789**.
3. Go to "License Renewal", read and check the attestations, and proceed with your payment. Only visa or master cards are accepted.

PAPER RENEWAL

Allow 2-3 weeks for processing paper renewals.

1. Review and complete Sections I, II and III on the back of this form. Please update any address or phone information on this form. **Renewal Application is not valid unless the attestations are completed and initialed by the psychologist.**
