

**Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists
LICENSED SPECIALIST IN SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY
ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES: March 6, 2018**

Final Approved: June 26, 2018

The Licensed Specialist in School Psychology Advisory Committee [herein Committee] of the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists [Board] was noticed and agenda posted December 1, 2017. Dr. Carmen Broussard, called the meeting to order at 1:37 p.m. at 8706 Jefferson Highway, Suite B, Baton Rouge, LA 70809. Present were Committee Members, Drs. Carmen Broussard, George Hebert, Amy Childress and Ex Officio Member, Ms. Jaime Monic.

Dr. Hebert moved to approve the meeting agenda, the motion passed unanimously.

The committee reviewed the minutes from December 5, 2017. Dr. Hebert moved to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Broussard moved to enter executive session pursuant to LSA to discuss credentials for self-nominations for Jessica Clark and Stacey L. Johnson, for recommendation to the LSBEP the committee. Dr. Broussard move to close executive session to offer motions on the matter. The motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION:

1. Committee Updates: Ms. Monic updated the committee with regard to the status of their previously approved recommendations to the LSBEP as follows: 1) all candidates recommended by the committee for licensure were approved; 2) the LSBEP reviewed the questions posed by the LSSP committee and agreed that it would be appropriate for an LSSP to provide supervision in a university training clinic to provide training to other LSSP's.

After hearing updates, the committee requested to go back to the LSBEP for further clarification to ensure that a Licensed Specialist in School Psychology would count as an acceptable supervisor of testing, practicum and internship for graduate students in the specialist program, or training clinic (providing assessment and treatment at the university) and who are not pursuing licensure at a doctoral level, and without being overseen by a licensed psychologist.

2. Chapter 42: Ethics for the LSSP – The committee discussed their work on this revision to the Louisiana Administrative Code.

3. LSSP Committee Self-Nominations for the 2018-21 appointment – The committee reviewed two qualified applicants for the seat (Jessica Clark and Stacey Johnson). Dr. Broussard moved in favor of recommending Stacey Johnson for appointment to the LSSP Committee, noting that her experience and goals are consistent with the purpose of the LSSP committee.

Dr. Broussard moved to adjourn the meeting at 3:06 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.
