LICENSED SPECIALIST IN SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY
ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES: June 6, 2017

The Licensed Specialist in School Psychology Advisory Committee [herein Committee] of the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists [Board] was noticed and agenda posted June 5, 2017. Dr. Carmen Broussard, called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. at 8706 Jefferson Highway, Suite B, Baton Rouge, LA 70809. Present were Committee Members, Dr. Steven Welsh, Dr. Carmen Broussard, and Ex Officio Member, Ms. Jaime Monic. Dr. Amy Morvant was absent from this meeting

Dr. Broussard moved to approve the meeting agenda, the motion passed unanimously.

The committee reviewed the minutes from March 7, 2017. Dr. Broussard moved to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Broussard moved to enter Executive Session to conduct file reviews. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Welsh moved to close Executive Session to enter the following:

FILE REVIEWS [LSA-R.S. 42.6.1]:

Dr. Welsh reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of **Mandi G. Bonvillain, SPP**. Dr. Welsh, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of Ms. Bonvillain and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Broussard reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of **Ann Dettmann, SPP**. Dr. Broussard, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of Ms. Dettmann and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Welsh reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of **Shanette Dominik, SPP**. Dr. Welsh, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of Ms. Dominik and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Broussard reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of **Teronica Walls, SPP**. Dr. Broussard, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of Ms. Walls and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.
