LICENSED SPECIALIST IN SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY  
ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
MEETING MINUTES: September 25, 2018**

*FINAL APPROVED: MARCH 19, 2019*

The Licensed Specialist in School Psychology Advisory Committee [herein Committee] of the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists [Board] was noticed and agenda posted September 24, 2018. Dr. Amy Morvant, called the meeting to order on September 25, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. at 8706 Jefferson Highway, Suite B, Baton Rouge, LA 70809. Present were Committee Members, Dr. Amy Morvant, Dr. George Hebert, Ms. Stacey Johnson and Ex Officio Member Jaime Monic.

Dr. Hebert moved to amend the agenda to add an item to nominate a committee chair and correct the date of the minutes set for review from December 5, 2017 to June 26, 2018. Unanimously approve adding the nomination to the agenda. Dr. Hebert moved to approve the meeting agenda as amended, the motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Morvant called for nominations. Dr. Hebert nominated Dr. Morvant, Ms. Johnson seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

The committee reviewed the minutes from June 26, 2018. Dr. Hebert moved to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

**DISCUSSION:**

1. Committee Updates: Ms. Monic reported that the LSBEP accepted the LSSP's committee recommendations regarding licensure for Kandice Bateast from June 26, 2018. The committee inquired regarding outstanding applicants and obtaining a proper verification from NASP. Ms. Johnson volunteered to contact NASP to obtain a contact and establish a protocol for receiving proper verifications.

2. MARY ESTEVE – Sent a written inquiry regarding classifying Continuing Professional Development for teaching Crisis Prevention Institute's (CPI) verbal de-escalation techniques. The committee agreed that this training may be classified under section 4002.C Training and In-service, credit may be claimed once for the development and delivery of this training, one hour equals one credit. This credit is limited to 30 credits per reporting period. Subsequent credit for the same trainings will not be acceptable.

3. Chapter 42: Ethics for the LSSP – The committee discussed and continued to draft revisions to Chapter 42 (ethics) of the Louisiana Administrative Code.

Dr. Morvant moved to adjourn the meeting at 3:30 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.
